## 2023-2024 Season information

- Tentatively we are planning to start practices the first week October. We will have 2
  practices/competitions a week on Tuesdays and Fridays from 4:30 pm to 5:30pm at Arapahoe
  Bowling Center. Competitions will start the first week of November. No practices/competitions
  during the Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's weeks
- There will be the following fees **per bowler**:
  - \$60 pp individual and \$100 eam (split among team) which covers state awards and state tournament entries (Paid to the Colorado High School Bowling Foundation)
  - \$200 pp lineage for 20 weeks of practice/competitions (2 days a week) \*\*this is based off last year, but I am trying to get that reduced for this year\*\*
- Competition will be sanctioned by USBC. Cost is \$4, if not already sanctioned in Colorado.
- It is a 10-week season with the format for competition as 1 full team game and 2 baker games. It is scored with handicap
- Right now, we have 3 coaches from last year, Mike Lujan, David Kling, and Jared Kaufmann. The coaches are (or need to be, for new ones) USBC RVP/Safe Sport certified.
- State Tournament will be held in Colorado Springs on February 17-18, 2024. Center to be announced later.
- There will be an informational meeting at 4:30 pm on Tuesday, September 22, at Arapahoe Bowling center. At this time, we will discuss more information/rules on how all this all works and hopefully answer any questions you may have.
